#### **EUGENE CORPORON**

Conductor, Wind Ensemble

Eugene Corporon is conductor of the Wind Ensemble and Director of Wind Studies at the University of Cincinnati, College-Conservatory of Music. Mr. Corporon guides all aspects of the wind department, including the masters and doctoral programs in conducting. Mr. Corporon received the Bachelor of Arts Degree in performance from California State University, Long Beach, and the Master of Arts Degree in conducting and clarinet performance from the Claremont Graduate School. His performances have drawn praise from composers such as Vincent Persichetti, Karel Husa, H. Owen Reed, Leslie Bassett, Mario Davidovsky, Ross Lee Finney, and others. Mr. Corporon has held positions as Director of Wind Chamber Music and Conductor of the Symphonic and Concert Bands at California State University, Fullerton; Professor of Conducting and Director of Graduate Wind Conducting at the University of Wisconsin; Professor of Music and Director of Bands at the University of Northern Colorado; and Professor of Music and Director of Bands at Michigan State University, Mr. Corporon maintains an active guest conducting schedule and is in demand as a conducting teacher and visiting lecturer throughout the U.S. and Canada.

#### ANTHONY MAIELLO

Conductor, Symphonic Band

Anthony Maiello received both his Bachelor's and Master's degrees in music from Ithaca College, in 1965 and 1967, respectively. Mr. Maiello's many professional credits include clinician, adjudicator and guest conductor of All-State, Regional, All-County and All-City ensembles, with appearances throughout the U.S., Mexico, Canada, England, Europe and Bahamas. He conducted musical activities for the Gold Medal Ceremonies of the 1980 Winter Olympics in Lake Placid, New York, Mr. Maiello's academic experience includes extensive teaching in the public schools. He served as Professor of Music and Chairman of Performance at the Crane School of Music, Potsdam College of SUNY, Potsdam, New York, where his duties advanced instrumental included conducting, studio clarinet, woodwind and percussion techniques; and conductor of the Crane Wind Ensemble. Anthony Maiello travels widely presenting clinics, lectures and workshops, and guest conducting and adjudicating numerous music festivals. He is presently Director of Bands at George Mason University, where he conducts the Symphonic Band and Jazz Ensemble, and teaches several conducting courses.

## DR. WILLIAM H. SILVESTER

Conductor, Wind Ensemble

As the Director of Bands at the University at Buffalo, Dr. Silvester has a wide range of experience as a professional performer, conductor, clinician, adjudicator and music educator. He received his BA from Utah State University, MA from Brigham Young University and his EdD from Arizona State University. For fourteen years Dr. Silvester was a very successful high school band director; and as a university band conductor, he has appeared as a guest conductor throughout the United States and Europe. Dr. Silvester is in great demand as a clinician, adjudicator, and guest conductor. In these capacities, Dr. Silvester's talents will be utilized over thirty times this year alone.

At the University at Buffalo, Dr. Silvester conducts the Wind Ensemble and supervises the department of bands. In addition, he teaches conducting, graduate courses, and is active in the music-education program. For seven years Dr. Silvester has also been the Coordinator of the New Jersey Governor's School, Division of Music, and conductor of the NJ Governor's School Wind Ensemble.

After leaving public school education, Dr. Silvester taught at California State University, Northridge. He then accepted a position as the director of bands at Trenton State College where his bands performed at numerous state and national music conventions including those of the New Jersey Music Educators Association, Music Educators National Conference, and the College Band Directors National Association. Dr. Silvester's ensembles have received praise from such noted and diverse musical personalities as Vaclav Nelhybel, Alfred Reed, John Edmondson, Anne McGinty, Phil Farkas, David Uber, Seymour Barab, Timothy Mahr, and Colonel James Bankhead.

As a concerned music educator, Dr. Silvester has served over twenty years on state music boards in Utah, Arizona, and New Jersey. For many years he served New Jersey on the New Jersey Music Educators Association Executive Board as the State Chairman for Collegiate Chapters. Dr. Silvester has also served as the Chairman of the National Band Association, New Jersey Chapter and serves on the Executive Board of Performing Arts Consultants. With his years of experience in the field of music education and conducting, Dr. Silvester comes well equipped to understand the needs of students and educators on all levels.

# RODNEY WINTHER

Conductor, Symphonic Band

Mr. Winther is Associate Professor of Music and Director of Bands at the Ithaca College School of Music where he conducts the Wind Ensemble and teaches undergraduate and graduate conducting and wind literature. Known for his championing of contemporary music, Mr. Winther has received praise for his interpretations from such composers as Karel Husa, Lucas Foss, Witold Lutoslawski, Gunther Schuller, Joseph Schwantner, Samuel Adler and David Amram.

His guest conducting and teaching have taken him across the United States and abroad, most recently to the Republic of Malaysia as a cultural specialist sponsored by the United States Information Agency. His recordings with the Ithaca College Wind Ensemble have brought them national and international recognition, having been played on National Public Radio stations here and in Europe. These activities and his research in wind literature have resulted in his being selected as a clinician and music editor for the publishing firm of Boosey and Hawkes. Mr. Winther holds degrees from the University of Idaho (M.M. and B.Mus.Ed.) and was in residence at the Eastman School of Music for two years while working toward the D.M.A. degree in conducting. In addition to extensive public school teaching, he has also taught at Walla Walla College, Purdue University and Oregon State University. While at the Eastman School he served as assistant conductor of the Eastman Wind Ensemble and Wind Orchestra, studied privately with Donald Hunsberger and David Effron, and taught undergraduate conducting.

# Robert Jager Conductor, Wind Ensemble

Robert Jager was born in Binghamton, New York (1939) and received his education at the University of Michigan. For four years he served as the Staff Arranger at the Armed Forces School of Music while a member of the United States Navy. Currently, he is Professor of Music and Director of Theory and Composition at Tennessee Technological University in Cookeville, Tennessee.

Jager is a widely commissioned and performed composer with over fifty published compositions, and more than thirty commissions from some of the finest high school and university bands in the world, including the Tokyo Wind Symphony. He has won a number of awards for his music, including being the only three-time winner of the American Bandmasters Association's "Ostwald Award". In addition, he has won the "Roth Award" twice (National School Orchestra Association); received Kappa Kappa Psi's "Distinguished Service to Music Medal" in the area of composition in 1973; the 1975 "Friends of Harvey Gaul" bicentennial competition; the Tennessee Composer of the Year in 1973; the 1976 American School Band Directors Association's "Volkwein Award"; the National Band Association's "Citation of Excellence" in 1978; the "Distinguished Service Award" from Purdue University in 1979, and the "Orpheus Award" from the Xi Chi Chapter of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia in 1980. In the Spring of 1980, he was elected to membership in the American Bandmasters Association. He is also a member of Kappa Kappa Psi, Phi Mu Alpha and ASCAP.

He is active as a composer, conductor and lecturer, having conducted concerts, clinics and lectures throughout the United States, as well as in Canada, Europe and Japan.

# Mallory Thompson Conductor, Symphonic Band

Mallory Thompson is Director of Bands and Associate Professor of Conducting at the University of South Florida. As Director of Bands, Professor Thompson conducts the wind ensemble, chamber winds, and symphony band, teaches courses in conducting and repertoire, and directs the masters program in wind conducting. Ms. Thompson received the Bachelor's degree in music education and master of music degree in conducting from Northwestern University. While a student at Northwestern, she studied conducting with John Paynter and trumpet with Vincent Cichowicz. She received her Doctor of Musical Arts degree in conducting from The Eastman School of Music, where she was assistant conductor of the Eastman Wind Ensemble and studied with Donald Hunsberger.

# Stanley DeRusha

Conductor, Wind Ensemble

Stanley DeRusha, Professor of Music and Director of the Butler Symphony Orchestra, received his Bachelor's degree with honors from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee and his Master of Music degree in Conducting, cum laude, from the University of Wisconsin-Madison.

Mr. DeRusha has conducted throughout the United States, Canada, Europe and South America winning praise from composers William Schuman, Vincent Persichetti, Ernst Krenek, Joseph Schwantner, Gunther Schuller, Karel Husa, George Perle, John Downey and Aaron Copland among others for his interpretation of their music, as well as receiving critical acclaim for his interpretation of the standard repertoire.

Mr. DeRusha has been music director of the Sinfonica de Vientos de Boyaca (Columbia S.A.), the Festival Orchestra including members of the Fine Arts String Quartet (Milwaukee, Wisconsin), the Stravinsky Players of the Milwaukee Symphony, the Lansing Chamber Orchestra (Lansing, Michigan) and guest conductor of the Orquesta Filharmonica de Bogota and Orquesta Sinfonica de Colombia, in addition to numerous guest appearances. He is principal guest conductor of the Orquesta Sinfonica de Antioquia, Colombia, S.A.

Mr. DeRusha has appeared as soloist with the Kenosha Symphony, the Milwaukee Symphony, the Woodwind Arts Quintet, and the St. Louis Symphony Orchestra among others. He appeared on radio and television in the United States, Japan, Europe, and South America and can be heard on Orion and Gasparo records and compact discs.

He was formerly on the faculty of the University of Hartford, where he was Founder and Music Director of the Connecticut Valley Youth Wind Ensemble, the high school honors band comprised of the finest musicians from throughout the entire State of Connecticut. In addition, he served as Director of the University's Summer Youth Music Program.

Dr. Boonshaft is also a consultant for Boosey & Hawkes Music Publishers and Kendor Music Publishers, and is an Advisory Board member and adjudicator for the Fiesta International Music Festivals in Mexico as well as Encore International. In addition, he held the post of Music Director and Conductor of the Metropolitan Wind Symphony of Boston from 1982-1986. Active as a proponent of the new literature for concert band, he has conducted world premieres by such notable composers as W.F. McBeth, Fisher Tull, H. Owen Reed, Vaclav Nelhybel, Robert Washburn, Elliot Del Borgo, Herbert Deutsch, Robert Hawkins, Larry Lipkis, Ian McDougall, Reber Clark, Roland Barrett and Jared Spears. James Croft, Professor of Music and Director of Bands at Florida State University, received his BME from Cornell College, an MA from Northern Iowa University and the DME from the University of Oklahoma.

Croft taught for twenty-one years in the public schools of Iowa and Wisconsin. He has presented clinics and workshops at a number of colleges and universities throughout the country. Widely sought as a guest conductor, lecturer, adjudicator and clinician, he has acted in these capacities in 42 states, Europe, Mexico, Canada, Israel and Australia.

Croft is a past president of both the National Band Association and the Southern Division of CBDNA. He is currently the CBDNA President-elect, serves as contributing editor of <u>The Instrumentalist</u> and as a consulting editor for <u>The Quarterly</u>.


#### Thomas Dvorak

A native of St. Clair Shores, Michigan, Dr. Berz began his teaching career in Leslie Michigan, where he directed the award winning Leslie High School Band for five years. He attended Michigan State University with major study in music education and conducting. Dr. Berz is a most versatile musician, having conducted bands, orchestras, opera and contemporary music on student, amateur and professional levels. He has appeared throughout North America as a conductor, clarinetist, clinician and adjudicator.

Bruce Yurko received his Bachelor of Science in music education from Wilkes College and his Masters Degree in performance and composition from Ithaca College School of Music. He has studied french horn with Douglas Hill and John Covert, conducting with Thomas Michalik and Frederick Fennell and composition with Karel Husa. From 1974 to 1981, Mr. Yurko was Director of Bands at Madison High School in Madison, New Jersey. Since 1981, he has been director of Wind Ensembles at Cherry Hill East and West High Schools in Cherry Hill, New Jersey. Additionally, at Cherry Hill East, Mr. Yurko directs the Chamber Wind Ensemble, the Brass Ensemble, the Orchestra, the Pit Orchestra and the Marching Band. In 1987, the Cherry Hill East Wind Ensemble toured the Soviet Union, performing in Moscow, Leningrad and Tallin Estonia. Bruce Yurko's compositions have been commissioned, performed and recorded by college and university wind ensembles across the United States, as well as in Europe. Mr. Yurko guest conducted the All South Jersey Symphonic Band in 1987 and 1994, the Salem County Honors Band in 1992 and has conducted his compositions with college and university ensembles. In 1992, he was selected to the Who's Who of American Teachers. Mr. Yurko lives in Washington Township, New Jersey, with his wife, Marcia, and their son, Brian.

# **Philip Smith**

## **Guest Artist**

Philip Smith joined the New York Philharmonic as Co-Principal Trumpet in October, 1978, and became Principal Trumpet at the start of the 1988-89 season. He is a graduate of the Juilliard School and was formerly a member of the Chicago Symphony Orchestra. Mr. Smith has performed world-wide as a soloist with symphonic wind ensembles, brass bands and orchestras. His frequent solo appearances with the Philharmonic have included December 1990 performances of Copland's "Quiet City" in memory of the composer, the world premiere in 1992 of Joseph Turrin's "Trumpet Concerto" and the U. S. premiere in 1992 of Jacques Hetu's "Trumpet Concerto." He is also a frequent performer with the Philharmonic Ensembles, and is featured in their New World Records recording of Ellen Taaffe Zwilich's "Concerto for Trumpet and Five Instruments." His latest solo recordings are available through his company, New Song Productions. Other recordings include Copland's "Quiet City" on Deutsche Grammophon, Haydn's "Trumpet Concerto" on the 1988 Radiothon recording and Turrin's "Trumpet Concerto" on the 1989 Radiothon recording. An avid brass band enthusiast, Mr. Smith has appeared as Bandmaster with the Goteborg Brass Band (Sweden), Black Dyke Mills (Britain) and numerous Army Bands. He is on the faculty of The Juilliard School and Manhattan School of Music.

Jack Stamp, Conductor of University Bands and Associate Professor of Music at Indiana University of Pennsylvania, received is Bachelor of Science in Music Education from Indiana University of Pa., an MM in Percussion Performance from East Carolina University in Greenville, North Carolina and a DMA in Wind Conducting from Michigan State University.

Stamp has had numerous guest conducting, adjudicating and clinician appearances through out the United States, Canada and Great Britain. He has recorded several compact discs with The Keystone Winds and with the IUP Wind Ensemble and Symphony Band for Citadel Records. Citadel Records also recently released a compact disc entitled "The Music of Jack Stamp". He has served as a Guest Conductor/Clinician at the Cincinnati College/Conservatory Wind Conducting Symposium. He has presented papers and sessions for CBDNA and the College Music Society.

Having studied composition with David Diamond, Joan Tower, Fisher Tull, and Robert Washburn, Jack Stamp has become a highly regarded composer in the Band medium. More recent published compositions include *Gavorkna Fanfare*, *Chorale & Toccata*, *Elegy & Affirmation*, and Canticle. His works have been performed through out the nation by many of the finest ensembles possible.

### George N. Parks

## Conductor, Symphonic Band

George Parks is Professor of Music at the University of Massachusetts at Amherst. His responsibilities include directing the Minuteman Marching Band, University Concert Band, Basketball Pep Band, Professor of Tuba, Tubist with the Faculty Brass Quintet, and Supervisor of Student Teachers. Under his direction, the Minuteman Marching Band has received a national reputation for excellence, having performed at Presidential Inaugural Ceremonies, NFL Half-time Shows and the Bands of America Grand National Championships.

Mr. Parks received his B.S. degree in Music Education from West Chester University, West Chester, Pa., and his Master of Music in Tuba Performance from Northwestern University in Evanston, Illinois. He has presented clinic and taken part in panel discussions at CBDNA conferences, MENC All-Eastern Conferences, Massachusetts Music Educators conferences and many others. He is very active in student leadership development, having founded the George N. Parks Leadership Academy in 1978. The academy continues to offer nationally renown leadership programs for over 2,800 students each year.

Mr. Parks has been awarded the Chancellor's Medal for Distinguished Service, the University of Massachusetts Distinguished Teachers Award, The University Alumni Association Distinguished Service Award, The Lowell Mason Music Education Award, and is a Hall of Fame inductee for both the World Drum Corps Hall of Fame and the Massachusetts Instrumental Conductors Association.

#### Dr. Michael Votta

Conductor, Wind Ensemble

Michael Votta, Jr. is a member of the faculty of Duke University where he holds the rank of Associate Professor, serves as Director of the Wind Symphony, and teaches courses in conducting and in the performance of 20th Century music. Under his direction, the Wind Symphony has received critical acclaim in the United States and Europe for its "fine balance, and exceptional musicality," its quality of repertoire and its imaginative programming. He has taught conducting seminars in the US, Austria and Israel, and has conducted and lectured at conferences of numerous organizations including the Eastern Division CBDNA, the North Carolina Music Educators' Association, the New York State School Music Association, and the Ohio Music Educators' Association.

### Robert W. Smith

Conductor, Symphonic Band

Robert W. Smith is one of the most popular and prolific composers of concert band literature in America today. He has over 300 publications with such publishers as Warner Brothers, CPP/Belwin, Hal Leonard, Jenson, Studio PR, Musicworks, and Columbia Pictures. He received a Bachelor of Music Education from Troy State University (AL) and a Master of Music from the University of Miami (FL).

His compositions and arrangements have been used in a variety of situations. From the welcoming ceremonies in Japan honoring President Ronald Reagan to Opening Day at Dodger Stadium . . . . from the opening of the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade telecast to the Ringling Bros/Barnum & Bailey Circus and the Olympic Games, his music is widely accepted by all ages. Recent commissions include the United States Air Force Band of Flight, the Gemeinhardt Flute Company, George Mason University, James Madison University, East Tennessee State University, and the University of Alabama-Birmingham.

As a conductor and clinician, Mr. Smith has performed throughout the United States, Canada, Japan and the United Kingdom. He is currently teaching at James Madison University in Harrisonburg, VA.

#### Rodney Winther

Conductor, Wind Ensemble

Rodney Winther is the newly-appointed Director of Wind Studies and Professor of Music at the University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music. His duties at CCM include conducting both the Wind Symphony and the Chamber Winds, while also teaching Masters and Doctorate students in Wind Conducting. Prior to this, Mr. Winther was Director of Bands and Professor of Music at the Ithaca College School of Music for fifteen years.

Mr. Winther's frequent appearances as a guest conductor and clinician have taken him across the United States and abroad, including the Republic of Malaysia as a cultural specialist sponsored by the United States Information Agency. The past two years in the United States have seen him conduct various festival bands in Pennsylvania, Virginia, New Jersey and New York, in addition to All-State groups in Alabama, Vermont, Massachusetts and Connecticut. His recordings with the Ithaca College Wind Ensemble (Marks Records) have brought them national and international recognition.

Mr. Winther holds degrees from the University of Idaho (M.M. and B.Mus.Ed.) and was in residence at the Eastman School of Music for two years while working toward the D.M.A. in conducting. In additions to extensive public school teaching, he has also taught at Walla Walla College, Purdue University and Oregon State University. While at the Eastman School, he served as assistant conductor of the Eastman Wind Ensemble and Wind Orchestra, studied privately with Donald Hunsberger and David Effron, and undergraduate conducting.

## Anthony J. Maiello

Conductor, Symphonic Band

Anthony J. Maiello received both his Bachelor's and Master's Degrees in Music from Ithaca College in 1965 and 1967, respectively. His many professional credits include clinician, adjudicator and guest conductor of All-State, All-State Sectional, Regional, District, All-County and All-City Ensembles, with appearances throughout the United States, Canada, Mexico, England, Europe, the Netherlands and the Bahamas. He conducted musical activities for the Gold Medal Ceremonies at the 1980 Olympics in Lake Placid, NY, has served as NYSMA adjudicator, clinician with Yamaha, consultant and clinician for Warner Bros. Publications, President of the IAJE-New York State Chapter and as a musical director for Music Festivals International. He is an elected member of the American Bandmasters Assn and ASCAP, and holds membership in the NBA, CBDNA. NYSMA, Virginia Jazz Service Organization, the College Music Society and the American Symphony Orchestra League.

Mr. Maiello served as Professor of Music and Chairman of Performance at the Crane School of Music, Pottsdam College of SUNY. He travels widely presenting clinics, lectures and workshops, and guest conducting and adjudicating numerous music festivals. He is presently Professor of Music and Director of Instrumental Studies at George Mason University, Fairfax, Virigina where he conducts the Symphony Orchestra and Wind Ensemble and teaches several conducting courses. Mr. Maiello has also served as Associate Conductor of the McLean Orchestra, McLean, Virginia.

# James Croft Conductor, Wind Ensemble

James Croft, Professor of Music and Director of Bands at Florida State University received his BME from Cornell College, his MA from Northern Iowa University, and his doctorate from the University of Oklahoma. Dr. Croft taught for twenty-one years in the public schools of Iowa and Wisconsin. In 1972 he joined the faculty of the University of South Florida where he served as Director of Bands until assuming his present position at Florida State in 1980.

Dr. Croft has conducted state and honors ensembles throughout the Eastern United States and has presented workshops and clinics at numerous colleges and universities throughout this country and in Europe, Mexico, Canada, Israel, and Australia. His Florida State Winds were featured at the National Conference of the British Association of Symphonic Bands and Wind Ensembles during a tour of Britain. Included in Dr. Croft's appearances as clinician, guest conductor, or lecturer are the National Music Camp (Interlochen), London Royal Academy of Music, Royal Marine School of Music in Portsmouth, the Central Army Orchestra in Budapest, The Ensemble Barrundeum in Prague, the Matan Music Camp in Israel, the World Association of Symphonic Band and Ensembles and the Mid-West International Band and Orchestra Clinic.

Dr. Croft is a past president of both the National Band Association and college Band Directors National Association and the Atlantic Coast Conference Band Directors Association. He also serves as a contributing editor for *The Instrumentalist* and as a consulting editor for *The Quarterly*. An elected member of the American Bandmasters Association and Phi Beta Mu, he maintains an active interest in the Florida Bandmasters Association, MENC, and the World Association of Symphonic Bands and Ensemble. He has been recognized by both Cornell College and the University of Oklahoma as a distinguished alumnus, and in 1997 he was selected for a University Teaching Award and recognized as the University Educator of the year.

# Bobby Adams Conductor, Symphonic Band

Bobby Adams is Director of Bands, Coordinator of Instrumental Music, and Associate Professor of Music Education at the Stetson University School of Music. He holds degrees from Morehead State University, Murray State University, and Florida State University. Prior to his appointment at Stetson University in 1987, Dr. Adams taught in the public schools of Indiana and Florida for twenty-five years.

During his tenure at Stetson the Symphonic Band has performed at numerous conventions and conferences including the Florida Bandmasters Association, Florida Music Educators Association, Georgia Music Educators Association, Southern Division MENC Conference, College Band Directors National Association/National Band Association Southern Division Conference, and the American Bandmasters Association National Convention.

Dr. Adams regularly presents clinics at state, regional, and national conferences and conducts all-state and honor bands throughout the eastern United States. He is president-elect of the College Band Directors National Association-Southern Division, a past-president of the Florida Bandmasters Association and the Florida Music Educators Association. In addition, he has served on the Board of Directors of the National Band Association and is chairman of the Board of Directors of the Florida Bandmasters Association Hall of Fame. Dr. Adams maintains an active interest in the Music Educators National Conference, the College Band Directors National Association, the National Band Association, the World Association for Symphonic Bands and Ensembles, and is an elected member of Phi Beta Mu and the American Bandmasters Association.
